

<u>Little Oaks Montessori French – Monday</u> <u>20th January 2020</u>

This week we continue with our weather topic, introducing Phillippe our Nounours (Teddy) who the children will be saying Bonjour to and telling him their name in French – Je m'appelle

We will be practising how we are feeling in French and remembering the new 'I am cold' phrase which is J'ai froid. We'll see how many new weather words the children can remember from last week – neige (snow), pluie (rain), vent (wind) and soleil (sun) and the different actions that go with them.

Our songs this week are Quel Temps Fait-II? which we introduced last week plus the popular penguin song from last year which includes some very funky dance moves! We will have everyone up on their feet moving and grooving as they learn the words and actions.

Following on from last week's counting activity, where we counted little penguins, we will be introducing ice cubes (sugar cubes) this week and the penguins can balance on top of them as we count.

The story is about Bertha the Witch who gets dressed ready for different weather and each time she opens her front door the weather has changed!
