We will introduce ourselves this week again to Phillippe the bear and practise saying how we are feeling, including our new phrase 'J'ai froid' (I'm cold).

We will practise the weather words we have been learning, along with their actions and then take a look at the winter clothing Phillippe is wearing. The new words we will introduce today are chapeau (hat), écharpe (scarf), gants (gloves) and bottes (boots). Our splat game will help practise the new words, before we take it in turns to undress Phillippe and try to remember the clothing names.

The children are enjoying our two new Winter songs – Quel temps fait-il? and La Danse des Pingouins, and we also have a new little rhyme about two penguins called Ronnie and Reg!

Our counting activity this week is teddy bears (les nounours) and our story is called Mon Vêtements (My Clothes) and is a lovely lift-the-flap book looking at the different clothes we wear for different types of weather.
